Located on the University of Toronto St. George campus, in the heart of the city, Graduate House welcomes full-time masters and doctoral students, along with students from the Faculties of Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Nursing, and Law.

Housed in one of Toronto's architectural landmarks, Graduate House is the only residence at UofT reserved exclusively for masters- and doctoral-level students, along with the Second-Entry Professional Faculties.

Graduate House is a suite style residence with 3 and 4 bedroom suites. Each suite is fully furnished and contains 2 or 3 bathrooms, a kitchen, and a living area.

In the building there are a number of lounges and study areas with wifi, a music room, a reading room with newspapers and periodicals from around the world, three television spaces, and a games room with a pool table, ping pong table, and foosball table. Laundry facilities are available in the building and underground parking is also available.

Life at Graduate House provides lots of opportunities to try new things and meet new people. Our student Graduate House Council hosts social events and residents can participate in an extensive intramural sports program.

Our Residence Life Staff coordinates regular activities, groups and workshops and hosts a wide range of events including weekly movies and coffee nights, courtyard brunches, and education events. In the summer, Graduate House comes alive with building-wide BBQs and outdoor movies. We also offer pick-up sports and trips around the city to local attractions.

Our Residence Life Team offers support if you experience academic or personal difficulty, challenges with your suite mates, or if you need support after hours.





how fees work.

All fees are charged monthly and are prorated to reflect both your offer date and move-out date. You do not have to pay up front for your entire visit (simply your first and last month) and you only have to give one full month's written notice when you wish to leave. Please note that all summer residents are required to live at Graduate House for a minimum of 6 weeks and must vacate residence no later than Wednesday, August 23, 2017.

All fees owed by U of T students are charged directly to their ROSI account. Non U of T students are required to pay their monthly fees via certified cheque or money order only and are required to provide a \$400 refundable damage deposit upon move-in.

Graduate House monthly fees for 2017-2018 are \$1127 for a premium single, \$1010 for a regular single, and \$771 for a shared double room.

There applicants will find all of the latest information on how to apply to Graduate House including a link to our online application. All summer applicants must be affiliated (i.e. student, staff, etc.) with a post-secondary institution either in North America or overseas.

Successful applicants will be contacted via email and will be given a minimum of one week to respond to any offer.

Prior to move-in, all new residents will be invited to fill out a Suitemate Allocation Questionnaire. The answers will be used to determine suitemate compatibility. Graduate House invites applications from individuals requiring accessible housing.
