

GLOBAL PROFESSIONAL LLM CHECKLIST FOR ONLINE APPLICATION

To apply for the Faculty of Law's Global Professional Master of Laws (GPLLM) program, please go to the University of Toronto's <u>School of Graduate Studies (SGS)</u> website to complete the online Admissions Application. The SGS Admissions Application is a standard application form that is used for application to all graduate programs at the University of Toronto. The GPLLM application deadline is **Monday, June 30, 2014**. If you have any questions, please contact the GPLLM Coordinator at 416-978-1400.

Please note that all GPLLM applications are reviewed by our Admissions Committee and are considered on a rolling basis. Therefore, early submission is encouraged. The Faculty of Law may request an inperson interview with and/or writing sample from potential candidates during the application process. You will be notified via email to set up an appointment, if necessary.

Graduate Admissions Application: New Applicants and Returning Applicants

All New Applicants must <u>Register</u> to obtain an applicant number and password in order to initiate the application process. If you are a Returning Applicant who has applied to a U of T graduate program in the past, you will need to log in to the SGS website using your existing applicant number and password.

Academic Background

In addition to electronic copies of transcripts uploaded to the SGS website, official transcripts must be submitted directly to the Faculty of Law from each post-secondary institution attended.
Please ensure that all international transcripts include a description of the grading scheme.
