### GLOBAL PROFESSIONAL LLM CHECKLIST FOR ONLINE APPLICATION

To apply for the Faculty of Law's Global Professional Master of Laws (GPLLM) program, please go to the University of Toronto's [School of Graduate Studies \(SGS\)](#) website to complete the online Admissions Application. The SGS Admissions Application is a standard application form that is used for application to all graduate programs at the University of Toronto. The GPLLM application deadline is **Monday, June 30, 2014**. If you have any questions, please contact the GPLLM Coordinator at 416-978-1400.

Please note that all GPLLM applications are reviewed by our Admissions Committee and are considered on a rolling basis. Therefore, early submission is encouraged. The Faculty of Law may request an in-person interview with and/or writing sample from potential candidates during the application process. You will be notified via email to set up an appointment, if necessary.

#### Graduate Admissions Application: New Applicants and Returning Applicants

- All New Applicants must [Register](#) to obtain an applicant number and password in order to initiate the application process. If you are a Returning Applicant who has applied to a U of T graduate program in the past, you will need to log in to the SGS website using your existing applicant number and password.

#### Academic Background

- In addition to electronic copies of transcripts uploaded to the SGS website, official transcripts must be submitted directly to the Faculty of Law from each post-secondary institution attended. Please ensure that all international transcripts include a description of the grading scheme.

- For the GPLLM, TOEFL (minimum Internet-based test score of 100, with a 22 out of 30 for the writing/speaking portions) is the preferred English test. We will also consider IELTS, COPE and MELAB test results.
