This special volume of the *CJWL* showcases the first six judgments of *The Women's Court of Canada (WCC)*, an innovative project bringing together academics, activists, and litigators in order literally to rewrite the Canadian Charter equality jurisprudence. Taking inspiration from Oscar Wilde, who once said "the only duty we owe to history is to rewrite it", the *WCC* operates as a virtual court, and 'reconsiders' leading equality decisions. The *WCC* renders alternative decisions as a means of articulating fresh conceptions of substantive equality. As future decisions of the *WCC* are released they will be published in a special section of the *CJWL*.
