"A paper relevant to the multi-faceted interaction between insurance coverage and tort claims, which should include a discussion of issues arising in Insurance Law, Tort Law and/or the Civil Procedure of a Province or the Federal Court as it pertains to Tort or Insurance Litigation."

The prize is open to any student currently enrolled in the Faculty of Law of any university in Canada. The papers will be judged on academic merit by a distinguished panel of at least 5 eminent persons drawn from the faculties of Canadian Law Schools, the Bench and the practising Bar. One winner will be selected. The papers must be original, academic in style and scholarly in content.

The deadline for submission of the papers is 5:00 pm EST on February 29, 2016. The winner will be notified following the end of the 2015 - 2016 academic year and publicly acknowledged at the Annual Meeting of Canadian Defence Lawyers on May 26, 2016.
