**Scholarships**

The HCLA Board is pleased to announce that Altima Dental and MCI The Doctor's Office will be funding and presenting the HELLENIC PROFESSIONALS' SCHOLARSHIP (DENTISTRY, MEDICINE, LAW) for 2019-2020 for the benefit of law students of Hellenic Canadian origin. The HCLA Board will grant one (1) scholarships in the amount of \$3,500.

**Eligibility**

**THE HELLENIC PROFESSIONALS' SCHOLARSHIP (DENTISTRY, MEDICINE, LAW)** will be granted, at the Board's discretion, to one (1) applicant who also meet the eligibility criteria and selection criteria.

A successful applicant for the scholarship must meet all of the following criteria:

- a) be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or protected person;
- b) be enrolled in an accredited Canadian law school as of September 2015 or be registered to write the Bar Exams in a Canadian jurisdiction;
- c) have completed the first year of an LL.B., J.D., or any LL.B or J.D. joint program;
- d) be an HCLA member, in good standing; and,
- e) must not be a past recipient of the Justice Andromache Karakatsanis Student Scholarship.

**Selection  
Criteria**

In selecting a successful applicant, the Board may consider (but will not be limited to) the following criteria:

- a) outstanding scholastic achievement in post-secondary and legal education;
- b) involvement in the Hellenic community; and
- c) involvement in the community at large.

The Board may also consider the applicant's financial needs or other special circumstances that may warrant financial support from the HCLA.

**Required  
Submissions**

To be considered for the scholarship, an applicant must submit the following:

- a) all official post-secondary transcripts (i.e. undergraduate, graduate, law school);
- b) a résumé;
- c) a cover letter (max. 450 words) outlining the reasons the applicant believes he/she should be chosen as a recipient of a scholarship. The letter should include the applicant's name, address, telephone number, e-mail address and current educational institution along with the applicant's anticipated graduation date;
- d) names of 2 references (with full contact particulars).
