One winner will be selected. The papers must be original, academic in style and scholarly in content.

4.	Essays must be submitted to Randi Glass, Executive Director by email at randi@cdlawyers.org no later than 5:00 EST, May 3, 2017.
5.	The author's name and law school should be noted on the front page of the essay, but must not be shown on any other pages of the essay.
6.	Submissions of an essay implies that it is the author's own original, unpublished work. Papers submitted for a law school course are eligible.
7.	The winning essay may be published by Canadian Defence Lawyers in a suitable venue.
