



THE FACILITIES

If you want to live close to the St.George Campus in a lively student family community in the heart of downtown Toronto, this is the place!

Families whose main priority is a quiet living space may prefer to look at off-campus housing in residential neighborhoods, for assistance visit www.housing.utoronto.ca.

Our two 21-storey buildings are on the east side of campus, near Yonge & Bloor streets.

In addition to 712 apartments, there is a rooftop garden, recreation rooms, family drop- in centre, activities and events for the whole family, a bicycle storage room, underground tenant/visitor parking, a free store and an innovative childcare centre operated by George Brown College.

THE APARTMENT UNITS

Bachelor (Studio Apartment)

Approx. 340 sq. ft For a couple without children.

Standard One-Bedroom Apartment

Approx 385 sq. ft.

For a couple with one child, or a single parent with one child.

Large One-Bedroom Apartment

Approx. 400-445 sq.ft.

Two-Bedroom apartment

Approx 592 sq. ft.

For a couple with one or two children, or a single parent with one or two children.

Although the apartments are basic and unfurnished, electric stoves and refrigerators are provided. Tenants must make their own arrangements for telephone, internet, and cable TV.

ELIGIBILITY

Tenancy is limited to full-time U of T students proceeding towards a **Bachelor's**, **Master's or PhD degree**, and to students in the Transitional Year Program (**TYP**), who live full-time with their spouse (common-law or married) and/or their children.

Special consideration is given to students who are single parents, guardians, and students with a documented significant disability for whom a place in university housing is necessary to achieve their defined academic goals.

CHILDCARE & SCHOOLS

The onsite childcare centre (416-415-2604) offers full and part-time care for children 6mos to 6 years old. There is a waiting list, but priority is given to children who live in the buildings. TENANT INSURANCE

The apartments are leased on a 12-month basis. Only the student, his/her partner and/or children are permitted to live here. As this is a University Residence, subletting, assigning or unauthorized occupants are not permitted.

Extended family members and friends are likewise not permitted to stay for extended periods of time. Guests are required to register at the Residence Office.
