Ways to participate:

Presentations - We welcome student presentations, 3-5 minutes in length on projects covering a vast array of issues that explore urban problem-solving with a long-term vision. Projects will be presented to all participants at the beginning of the break out session.

Poster Boards or other displays - Poster boards will be on display throughout the symposium with an opportunity to (briefly) introduce your project to the entire audience before lunch. Attendees will be free to explore your work and speak with you directly during lunch.

Facilitations - We welcome students who are skilled at listening, sharing, and guiding discussions to help moderate small groups as we tackle problems and imagine possibilities for the future of cities. Moderators will be asked to report back at the end of the break-out sessions to share key discussion points during the plenary session.

Conversation starters - If you have a fascinating thought about where cities are heading, and would love to discuss it with others, but have not formed it into a formal presentation yet...no problem! We encourage instigators of interesting topics to pitch a 1-2minute conversation starter before lunch.
